Astounding Astragalus in Humboldt County and Beyond

Astragalus (milkvetch, locoweed) is a large and particularly diverse genus within the western United States, with a large number of rare and endemic taxa. In this talk, **Professor Kerry Byrne** (Environmental Science and Management, HSU) will provide an overview of the genus *Astragalus* in California and beyond, highlight some of the interesting *Astragalus* species found



in Humboldt County, and describe some of the ongoing conservation research she is involved in with a Federally Endangered *Astragalus* species in southern Oregon.
